Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

7 8 9 Section 1. (a) A city or county shall not adopt or enforce an ordinance or resolution, respectively, that establishes or provides for the operation of a guaranteed income program.

10 11 12 (b) Any ordinance or resolution prohibited by subsection (a) that was adopted prior to July 1, 2025, shall be null and void.(c) As used in this section, "guaranteed income program" means a
