AN ACT concerning cremation; relating to the authority of coroners to issue permits; amending K.S.A. 65-2426a and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas.

Section 1. K.S.A. 65-2426a is hereby amended to read as follows: 6 65-2426a. No dead body, as such term is defined in subsection (4) of 7 K.S.A. 65-2401, and amendments thereto, shall be cremated unless a 8 coroner's permit to cremate has been furnished to authorize such 9 10 cremation. The coroner's permit to cremate shall be authorized by the coroner of the jurisdiction in which the death occurs. The coroner may 11 12 transfer jurisdiction to another jurisdiction if the coroners of both jurisdictions agree to the transfer in writing. If the transfer occurs, then 13 the authority to cremate follows and is limited to the new jurisdiction. A 14 telefacsimile signed copy of the coroner's permit to cremate which 15 authorizes the cremation shall constitute legal authorization for such 16 cremation under this section. The provisions of this section shall be 17 construed as supplemental to and as a part of the uniform vital statistics 18 act. Any person who knowingly violates this section, upon conviction, 19 shall be fined not more than \$500. 20
