1 AN ACT concerning wildlife; relating to the transferability of deer
2 permits.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. (a) The secretary shall establish a system to approve and
6 administer the transfer of regular landowner or tenant hunt-on-your-own-
7 land big game permits issued under K.S.A. 32-937(g), and amendments
8 thereto, from the original recipient of such permit to a nonresident of the
9 state of Kansas solely for the purpose of hunting white-tailed deer.

10 (b) Such transfer system established under subsection (a) shall meet
11 the following requirements:

12 (1) Any transfer shall not occur until all nonresident hunting permits
13 issued under K.S.A. 32-937(l), and amendments thereto, have been filled
14 in each management unit where the regular landowner or tenant hunt-on-
15 your-own-land big game permit was issued for the applicable white-tailed
16 deer season;

17 (2) any recipient of a nonresident hunting permit issued under K.S.A.
18 32-937(l), and amendments thereto, is not eligible for a transfer under this
19 section during the applicable white-tailed deer season of the permit issued
20 under K.S.A. 32-937(l), and amendments thereto;

21 (3) the secretary shall allow the transferee to designate whether the
22 transferee will hunt both antlered and antlerless white-tailed deer or only
23 antlerless white-tailed deer pursuant to the permit transferred under this
24 section;

25 (4) the secretary may charge a transfer fee, not to exceed half the cost
26 of a nonresident hunting permit issued under K.S.A. 32-937(l), and
27 amendments thereto, for transfers designated for antlered and antlerless
28 white-tailed deer, and not to exceed the cost of the original permit for the
29 regular landowner or tenant hunt-on-your-own-land big game permit under
30 K.S.A. 32-937(g), and amendments thereto, for transfers designated for
31 antlerless white-tailed deer.

32 (5) The secretary shall not prohibit nor restrict the sale of regular
33 landowner or tenant hunt-on-your-own-land big game permit under K.S.A.
34 32-937(g), and amendments thereto, by the original permit holder to a
35 nonresident, so long as the transfer is approved under the transfer system
36 established by the secretary pursuant to this section.

1 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
2 publication in the statute book.
