AN ACT concerning emergency medical services; relating to medical 1 2 directors; requiring provision of medical oversight; amending K.S.A. 3 2020 Supp. 65-6112, 65-6124 and 65-6126 and repealing the existing 4 sections. 5 6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:* 7 Section 1. K.S.A. 2020 Supp. 65-6112 is hereby amended to read as 8 follows: 65-6112. As used in this act article 61 of chapter 65 of the Kansas 9 Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto: 10 (a) "Administrator" means the executive director of the emergency 11 medical services board. 12 (b) "Advanced emergency medical technician" means a person who 13 holds an advanced emergency medical technician certificate issued 14 pursuant to this act. 15 "Advanced practice registered nurse" means an advanced practice (c) registered nurse as defined in K.S.A. 65-1113, and amendments thereto. 16 (d) "Ambulance" means any privately or publicly owned motor 17 18 vehicle, airplane or helicopter designed, constructed, prepared, staffed and 19 equipped for use in transporting and providing emergency care for 20 individuals who are ill or injured. 21 "Ambulance service" means any organization operated for the (e) 22 purpose of transporting sick or injured persons to or from a place where 23 medical care is furnished, whether or not such persons may be in need of 24 emergency or medical care in transit. 25 (f) "Board" means the emergency medical services board established 26 pursuant to K.S.A. 65-6102, and amendments thereto. 27 (g) "Emergency medical service" means the effective and coordinated 28 delivery of such care as may be required by an emergency that includes the 29 care and transportation of individuals by ambulance services and the 30 performance of authorized emergency care by a physician, advanced 31 practice registered nurse, professional nurse, a licensed physician assistant 32 or emergency medical service provider. 33 (h) "Emergency medical service provider" means an emergency 34 medical responder, advanced emergency medical technician, emergency 35 medical technician or paramedic certified by the emergency medical 36 services board.

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1 (i) "Emergency medical technician" means a person who holds an 2 emergency medical technician certificate issued pursuant to this act.

3 (j) "Emergency medical responder" means a person who holds an 4 emergency medical responder certificate issued pursuant to this act.

5 (k) "Hospital" means a hospital as defined by K.S.A. 65-425, and 6 amendments thereto.

7 (1) "Instructor-coordinator" means a person who is certified under this 8 act to teach or coordinate both initial certification and continuing 9 education classes.

(m) "Medical director" means a physician.

(n) "Medical oversight" means to review, approve and implement
 medical protocols and to approve and monitor the activities, competency
 and education of emergency medical service providers.

(o) "Medical protocols" mean means written guidelines that authorize 14 emergency medical service providers to perform certain medical 15 16 procedures prior to contacting a physician, physician assistant authorized by a physician, advanced practice registered nurse authorized by a 17 physician or professional nurse authorized by a physician. The medical 18 19 protocols shall be approved by a county medical society or the medicalstaff of a hospital to which the ambulance service primarily transports 20 21 patients, or if neither of the above are able or available to approve the 22 medical protocols, then the medical protocols shall be submitted to the 23 medical advisory council for approval.

(o) "Municipality" means any city, county, township, fire district orambulance service district.

(p) "Nonemergency transportation" means the care and transport of a sick or injured person under a foreseen combination of circumstances calling for continuing care of such person. As used in this subsection, transportation includes performance of the authorized level of services of the emergency medical service provider whether within or outside the vehicle as part of such transportation services.

(q) "Operator" means a person or municipality who has a permit tooperate an ambulance service in the state of Kansas.

(r) "Paramedic" means a person who holds a paramedic certificateissued pursuant to this act.

(s) "Person" means an individual, a partnership, an association, ajoint-stock company or a corporation.

(t) "Physician" means a person licensed by the state board of healingarts to practice medicine and surgery.

40 (u) "Physician assistant" means a physician assistant as defined in 41 K.S.A. 65-28a02, and amendments thereto.

42 (v) "Professional nurse" means a licensed professional nurse as 43 defined by K.S.A. 65-1113, and amendments thereto. 1

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5 6 (w) "Sponsoring organization" means any professional association, accredited postsecondary educational institution, ambulance service that holds a permit to operate in this state, fire department, other officially organized public safety agency, hospital, corporation, governmental entity or emergency medical services regional council, as approved by the executive director, to offer initial courses of instruction or continuing

7 education programs.

8 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2020 Supp. 65-6124 is hereby amended to read as 9 follows: 65-6124. (a) No physician, physician assistant, advanced practice registered nurse or licensed professional nurse; who gives emergency 10 instructions to an emergency medical service provider-as defined by-11 K.S.A. 65-6112, and amendments thereto, during an emergency; shall be 12 liable for any civil damages as a result of issuing the instructions, except 13 such damages that may result from gross negligence in giving such 14 15 instructions.

16 (b) No emergency medical service provider as defined by K.S.A. 65-17 6112, and amendments thereto, who renders emergency care during an emergency pursuant to instructions given by a physician, the supervising 18 19 physician for a physician assistant, advanced practice registered nurse or 20 licensed professional nurse shall be liable for civil damages as a result of 21 implementing such instructions, except such damages that may result from 22 gross negligence or by willful or wanton acts or omissions on the part of 23 such emergency medical service provider-as defined by K.S.A. 65-6112, and amendments thereto. 24

(c) No person certified as an instructor-coordinator shall be liable for any civil damages that may result from such instructor-coordinator's course of instruction, except such damages that may result from gross negligence or by willful or wanton acts or omissions on the part of the instructor-coordinator.

(d) No medical director who reviews, approves and monitors the
activities of emergency medical service providers provides medical
oversight shall be liable for any civil damages as a result of such review,
approval or monitoring medical oversight, except such damages that may
result from gross negligence in the provision of such review, approval or
monitoring medical oversight.

Sec. 3. K.S.A. 2020 Supp. 65-6126 is hereby amended to read as follows: 65-6126. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), each emergency medical service operator shall-have designate a medical director appointed by the operator of the service to review and implement medical protocols, approve and monitor the activities, competency and education of the emergency medical service providers to provide medical oversight.

43 (b) The board may approve an alternative procedure for medical
