1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION amending 2015 House Concurrent
2 Resolution No. 5016, relating to the adjournment of the senate and
3 house of representatives for periods during the 2015 regular session of
4 the legislature.

6 *Be it resolved by the the House of Representatives of the State of*
7 *Kansas, the Senate concurring therein:* That 2015 House Concurrent
8 Resolution No. 5016 is hereby amended to read as follows: "That the
9 legislature shall adjourn at the close of business of the daily session
10 convened on March 25, 2015, and shall reconvene on March 30, 2015,
11 pursuant to adjournment of the daily session convened on March 25,
12 2015; and

13 *Be it further resolved:* That the legislature shall adjourn at the close of
14 business of the daily session convened on April-3 2, 2015, and shall
15 reconvene on April 29, 2015, pursuant to adjournment of the daily session
16 convened on April-3 2, 2015; and

17 *Be it further resolved:* That the chief clerk of the house of
18 representatives and the secretary of the senate and employees specified by
19 the director of legislative administrative services for such purpose shall
20 attend to their duties each day during periods of adjournment, Sundays
21 excepted, for the purpose of receiving messages from the governor and
22 conducting such other business as may be required; and

23 *Be it further resolved:* That members of the legislature shall not
24 receive the per diem compensation and subsistence allowances provided
25 for in K.S.A. 46-137a (a) and (b), and amendments thereto, for any day
26 within a period in which both houses of the legislature are adjourned for
27 more than two days, Sundays excepted; and

28 *Be it further resolved:* That members of the legislature attending a
29 legislative meeting of whatever nature when authorized pursuant to law,
30 or by the legislative coordinating council, the president of the senate or
31 the speaker of the house of representatives, and members of a conference
32 committee attending a meeting of the conference committee authorized
33 by the president of the senate and the speaker of the house of
34 representatives during any period of adjournment for which members are
35 not authorized compensation and allowances pursuant to K.S.A. 46-137a,
36 and amendments thereto, shall receive compensation and travel expenses

1 or allowances as provided by K.S.A. 75-3212, and amendments thereto."
