

**SENATE BILL No. 185**

1 AN ACT concerning sexually violent predators; relating to reimbursement  
2 for costs incurred by counties.

3  
4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. (a) (1) Whenever a person civilly committed pursuant to  
6 K.S.A. 59-29a01 et seq., and amendments thereto, is in the custody of a  
7 county law enforcement agency, the costs incurred for the care and  
8 custody of such person by the county with custody of such person,  
9 including, but not limited to, costs of medical care and treatment, housing,  
10 food and transportation, shall be paid by such county.

11 (2) The secretary for aging and disability services shall reimburse  
12 such county from the Larned state hospital – sexual predator treatment  
13 program account of the state general fund for all costs that would have  
14 been paid from such account if such person had remained in the custody of  
15 the secretary for aging and disability services.

16 (3) If there are no moneys available in such account to pay any such  
17 reimbursements, the county may file a claim against the state pursuant to  
18 article 9 of chapter 46 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and amendments  
19 thereto.

20 (4) The secretary for aging and disability services shall develop and  
21 implement a procedure to provide such reimbursements on or before July  
22 1, 2015.

23 (b) All expenditures pursuant to this section from the Larned state  
24 hospital – sexual predator treatment program account of the state general  
25 fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts upon warrants of  
26 the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved  
27 by the secretary for aging and disability services or the secretary's  
28 designee.

29 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
30 publication in the Kansas register.
