1 AN ACT concerning education; providing for COVID-19 hazard pay for
2 teachers; making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal years
3 ending June 30, 2021, and June 30, 2022, for the department of
4 education.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 Section 1.

8 DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

9 (a) There is appropriated for the above agency from the following
10 special revenue fund or funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, all
11 moneys now or hereafter lawfully credited to and available in such fund or
12 funds, except that expenditures other than refunds authorized by law shall
13 not exceed the following:

14 COVID-19 hazard pay for teachers fund.....No limit
15 *Provided*, That, notwithstanding the provisions of any other statute, during
16 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, the director of the budget shall
17 determine the amount of moneys received by the state from the federal
18 consolidated appropriations act, 2021, public law 116-260, and any other
19 federal law that appropriates moneys to the state for aid for coronavirus
20 relief, that are identified as moneys that may be expended at the discretion
21 of the state: *Provided further*, That the director of the budget shall certify
22 the amount so determined to the director of accounts and reports and, at
23 the same time as such certification is transmitted to the director of
24 accounts and reports, shall transmit a copy of such certification to the
25 director of legislative research: *And provided further*, That, upon receipt of
26 each such certification, if the total certified amount is greater than
27 \$5,000,000, the director of accounts and reports shall transfer \$5,000,000
28 of the amount certified from the identified federal funds in the state
29 treasury to the COVID-19 hazard pay for teachers fund: *And provided*
30 *further*, That such funds shall be distributed to eligible teachers as
31 determined by the above agency.

12 the same time as such certification is transmitted to the director of
13 accounts and reports, shall transmit a copy of such certification to the
14 director of legislative research: *And provided further*, That, upon receipt of
15 each such certification, if the total certified amount is greater than
16 \$5,000,000, the director of accounts and reports shall transfer \$5,000,000
17 of the amount certified from the identified federal funds in the state
18 treasury to the COVID-19 hazard pay for teachers fund: *And provided*
19 *further*, That such funds shall be distributed to eligible teachers as
20 determined by the above agency.
21 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
22 publication in the Kansas register.
