If so, the legal services contractor may not be awarded the contract unless another state, the District of Columbia, or any possession or territory of the United States is among those existing clients."; and

On page 2, delete lines 5 to 11, and insert in lieu thereof:

"(4) A contingency fee shall not exceed twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000), regardless of the number of actions or proceedings or the number of attorneys or law firms involved in the matter, and exclusive of any costs and expenses provided for by the contract and actually incurred by the legal services contractor;"; and

On page 3, delete lines 5 to 11, and insert in lieu thereof:

"(8) (a) Within five (5) business days after the contract award, the Finance and Administration Cabinet shall post on its Web site each personal service contract for legal services that provides for payment by contingency fee and the accompanying written determinations by the Attorney General described in subsection (1) of this section. The contract and accompanying determinations shall remain on the Web site during the duration of the contract and any extension.
