

1 AN ACT relating to state symbols.

2 ***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

3 →Section 1. KRS 2.091 is amended to read as follows:

4 Coal~~[Kentucky agate]~~ is named and designated as the official rock of Kentucky.

5 →Section 2. KRS 2.094 is amended to read as follows:

6 Calcite~~[Coal]~~ is named and designated as the official mineral of Kentucky.

7 →Section 3. KRS 2.092 is amended to read as follows:

8 Kentucky agate~~[The fresh water pearl]~~ is named and designated the official~~[state]~~
9 gemstone of Kentucky.
