- (a)[1.] Transacting any business in this Commonwealth;
- (b)[2.] Contracting to supply services or goods in this Commonwealth;
- (c)[3.] Causing tortious injury by an act or omission in this Commonwealth;
- (d)[4.] Causing tortious injury in this Commonwealth by an act or omission outside this Commonwealth if he regularly does or solicits business, or engages in any other persistent course of conduct, or derives substantial revenue from goods used or consumed or services rendered in this Commonwealth, provided that the tortious injury occurring in this Commonwealth arises out of the doing or soliciting of business or a persistent course of conduct or derivation of substantial revenue within the Commonwealth;
- (e)[5.] Causing injury in this Commonwealth to any person by breach of warranty expressly or impliedly made in the sale of goods outside this Commonwealth when the seller knew such person would use, consume, or be affected by, the goods in this Commonwealth, if he also regularly does or solicits business, or engages in any other

persistent course of conduct, or derives substantial revenue from goods used or consumed or services rendered in this Commonwealth;

- (f)[6.] Having an interest in, using, or possessing real property in this Commonwealth, providing the claim arises from the interest in, use of, or possession of the real property, provided, however, that such in personam jurisdiction shall not be imposed on a nonresident who did not himself voluntarily institute the relationship, and did not knowingly perform, or fail to perform, the act or acts upon which jurisdiction is predicated;
- (g)[7.] Contracting to insure any person, property, or risk located within this Commonwealth at the time of contracting;
- (<u>h)</u>[8.] Committing sexual intercourse in this state which intercourse causes the birth of a child when:
 - <u>1.[a.]</u> The father or mother or both are domiciled in this state;
 - <u>2.[b.]</u> There is a repeated pattern of intercourse between the father and mother in this state; or
 - 3.[e.] Said intercourse is a tort or a crime in this state; or
- (i)[9.] Making a telephone solicitation, as defined in KRS 367.46951, into the Commonwealth.
- [(b) When jurisdiction over a person is based solely upon this section, only a claim arising from acts enumerated in this section may be asserted against him.]".
