**PURPOSE OF MEASURE:** This measure creates the “Kentucky equine education account” to support the University of Louisville Equine Industry Program, the University of Kentucky Ag Equine Programs, and the Bluegrass Community and Technical College North American Racing Academy.

**FISCAL EXPLANATION:** Beginning July 1, 2019, revenues that were previously deposited into the equine industry program trust from pari-mutuel tax collections will be deposited into the Kentucky equine education account and allocated equally among the three programs. There is no expected fiscal impact from this measure.
