4	TO	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	<u>(1)</u>	The Transportation Cabinet shall establish and maintain an emergency contact
6		information registry within the Kentucky Driver's License Information System
7		which shall be capable of storing next of kin and other emergency contact
8		information of individuals who are issued driver's licenses, commercial driver's
9		licenses, temporary instruction permits, motorcycle operator's licenses and
10		endorsements, and identification cards. Information in the registry shall be
11		accessible only to employees of the Transportation Cabinet and to law
12		enforcement officials and shall not be subject to the Kentucky Open Records Act,
13		<u>KRS 61.870 to 61.884.</u>
14	(2)	When an individual submits an application for an initial or renewal driver's
15		license, commercial driver's license, temporary instruction permit, motorcycle
16		operator's license or endorsement, or identification card, the individual shall be
17		furnished with an emergency contact information form, prepared by the
18		Transportation Cabinet, on which the individual may list the name, address,
19		telephone number, and relationship to the individual of at least one (1) contact
20		person whom the individual wishes to be contacted if the individual dies, is
21		rendered unconscious, or is seriously injured and unable to communicate with
22		the emergency contact person.
23	<u>(3)</u>	The contact person may or may not be the next of kin of the applicant, except that
24		if the applicant is under eighteen (18) years of age and is not emancipated, the
25		contact person shall include the parent, guardian, or custodian of the applicant.
26	<u>(4)</u>	The secretary of the Transportation Cabinet shall promulgate regulations under
27		KRS Chapter 13A to establish the rules to implement the emergency contact

1		registry established under this section, including but not limited to:
2		(a) The contents of the emergency contact information form;
3		(b) Where the individual may submit the completed form; and
4		(c) How an individual who has submitted the name of a contact person for
5		inclusion in the database may revise or update the emergency contact
6		information.
7	<u>(5)</u>	In the event of a motor vehicle accident or emergency situation in which an
8		individual dies, is rendered unconscious, or is seriously injured and unable to
9		communicate with the contact person specified in the database, law enforcement
10		personnel shall make a good-faith effort to notify the contact person of the
11		situation. However, the Transportation Cabinet, law enforcement personnel, and
12		law enforcement agencies shall not be held liable if unable to make contact with
13		the emergency contact person.
