2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:		
3	→ Section 1. KRS 189.930 is amended to read as follows:		
4	(1) As used in this section, "personal communication device" shall have the same		
5	meaning as in KRS 189.292.		
6	(2)[(1)] Upon the approach of an emergency vehicle equipped with, and operating, one		
7	(1) or more flashing, rotating, or oscillating red or blue lights, visible under normal		
8	conditions from a distance of five hundred (500) feet to the front of such vehicle; or		
9	the driver is given audible signal by siren, exhaust whistle, or bell, the driver or		
10	every other vehicle shall yield the right-of-way, immediately drive to a position		
11	parallel to, and as close as possible to, the edge or curb of the highway clear of any		
12	intersection, and stop and remain in such position until the emergency vehicle has		
13	passed, except when otherwise directed by a police officer or firefighter.		
14	(3)[(2)] Upon the approach of any emergency vehicle, operated in conformity with the		
15	provisions of subsection $(2)[(1)]$ of this section, the operator of every vehicle shall		
16	immediately stop clear of any intersection and shall keep such position until the		
17	emergency vehicle has passed, unless directed otherwise by a police officer of		
18	firefighter.		
19	(4)[(3)] No operator of any vehicle, unless he <u>or she</u> is on official business, shall		
20	follow any emergency vehicle being operated in conformity with the provisions of		
21	subsection (2) (1) of this section closer than five hundred (500) feet, nor shall he \underline{o}		
22	<u>she</u> drive into, or park the vehicle into, or park the vehicle within, the block where		
23	the vehicle has stopped in answer to an emergency call or alarm unless he or she is		
24	directed otherwise by a police officer or firefighter.		
25	(5) An operator of a motor vehicle shall not use a personal communication device to		
26	take, send, or view photographs or videos of any accident scene unless he or she		
27	is on official business or is involved in the accident.

1	<u>(6)[(4)]</u>	No vehicle, train, or other equipment shall be driven over any unprotected
2	hose	of a fire department when the hose is laid down on any street, private
3	drive	way, or track for use at any fire or fire alarm unless the fire department official
4	in co	mmand consents that the hose be driven over.
5	<u>(7)</u> [(5)]	Upon approaching a stationary emergency vehicle or public safety vehicle,
6	when	the emergency vehicle or public safety vehicle is giving a signal by displaying
7	alter	nately flashing yellow, red, red and white, red and blue, or blue lights, a person
8	who	drives an approaching vehicle shall, while proceeding with due caution:
9	(a)	Yield the right-of-way by moving to a lane not adjacent to that of the
10		authorized emergency vehicle, if:
11		1. The person is driving on a highway having at least four (4) lanes with
12		not fewer than two (2) lanes proceeding in the same direction as the
13		approaching vehicle; and
14		2. If it is possible to make the lane change with due regard to safety and
15		traffic conditions; or
16	(b)	Reduce the speed of the vehicle, maintaining a safe speed to road conditions,
17		if changing lanes would be impossible or unsafe.
18	<u>(8)</u> [(6)]	This section does not operate to relieve the person who drives an emergency
19	vehic	ele from the duty to operate the vehicle with due regard for the safety of all
20	perso	ons using the highway.
