2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 38 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) As used in this section:
6	(a) "Active duty combat" means performing the following services in the active
7	federal military of the United States:
8	1. Participation in an armed conflict;
9	2. Performance of a hazardous service relating to an armed conflict in a
10	foreign state; or
11	3. Performance of a duty through an instrumentality of war; and
12	(b) ''Official declaration of war'' means a declaration of war by the United
13	States Congress pursuant to Article 1, Section 8, Clause 11 of the United
14	States Constitution.
15	(2) Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the Kentucky National Guard and
16	any member of the Kentucky National Guard shall not be released from the state
17	into active duty combat unless the federal government has satisfied any
18	outstanding balance to the Kentucky National Guard, and the United States
19	Congress has:
20	(a) Passed an official declaration of war; or
21	(b) Taken official action pursuant to Article 1, Section 8, Clause 15 of the
22	United States Constitution to explicitly call forth the Kentucky National
23	Guard and any member of the Guard for enumerated purposes to expressly
24	execute the laws of the Commonwealth, repel invasion, or suppress
25	insurrections.
26	(3) Nothing in this section limits or prohibits the Governor from consenting to the
27	denloyment of any Kentucky National Guard member as set forth in Title 32 of
