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1 AN ACT relating to water pollution control.

## 2 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

- 3 → Section 1. KRS 224.16-080 is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (1) In accordance with the water quality standards established in 401 KAR 10:029 in
- 5 effect on March 24, 2021, which <u>were</u>[have been] submitted to and deemed
- 6 approved by the United States Environmental Protection Agency pursuant to its
- 7 2018 triennial review of Kentucky's water quality standards under 33 U.S.C. sec.
- 8 1313(c), any mixing zone for <u>a</u> bioaccumulative <u>chemical</u>[chemicals] of concern
- 9 assigned by the cabinet on or before September 8, 2004, shall be in effect from that
- date unless and until explicitly *changed or* extinguished by the cabinet after March
- 11 24, 2021. Any Kentucky Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permittee who
- 12 <u>seeks to rely on a mixing zone for a bioaccumulative chemical of concern</u>
- assigned by the cabinet on or before September 8, 2004, shall include information
- identifying the mixing zone in any application for the modification or renewal of
- 15 the relevant Kentucky Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit.
- 16 (2) Any change or extinguishment in mixing zone assignments for bioaccumulative
- chemicals of concern by the cabinet *pursuant to subsection* (1) of this section shall
- only be accomplished through a formal Kentucky Pollutant Discharge
- 19 Elimination System permitting action by the cabinet, including public notice and
- 20 <u>opportunity for comment, conducted pursuant to[the promulgation of]</u>
- 21 administrative regulations *promulgated in accordance with*[pursuant to] KRS
- Chapter 13A.
- → Section 2. KRS 224.16-090 is amended to read as follows:
- 24 (1) As used in this section, "rapid and complete mixing" means the limited area
- surrounding or downstream from a wastewater discharge location where complete
- 26 mixing of treated wastewater and receiving water occurs rapidly [, including]
- 27 through the use of a submerged high-rate multi-port [diffuser or] outfall structure.

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1	(2)	If a permit applicant specifically requests in an application for the issuance,
2		modification, or renewal of a Kentucky Pollutant Discharge Elimination System
3		permit that the cabinet take into account rapid and complete mixing occurring at
4		one (1) or more of its wastewater outfalls, the cabinet shall apply rapid and
5		complete mixing in establishing water quality-based effluent[permit] limitations
6		and conditions for any discharge regulated under <u>the[a]</u> Kentucky Pollutant
7		Discharge Elimination System permit <u>if</u> [where] the discharge occurs through a
8		submerged high-rate multi-port[ diffuser or] outfall structure.

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
