2 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

- 3 → Section 1. KRS 151B.285 is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (1) The Education and Workforce Development Cabinet shall administer and supervise
- 5 state employment offices and perform any other duties within the Act of Congress
- 6 entitled "An Act to provide for the establishment of a National Employment Service
- and for Cooperation with the State in the Promotion of Such System and for Other

- 9 amended, and known as the Wagner-Peyser Act. All duties and powers relating to
- the establishment, maintenance, and operation of free public employment offices
- are vested in the Education and Workforce Development Cabinet, except that at
- least one full-time free public employment office through the Kentucky Career
- 13 Center shall be open and fully operational when the unemployment rate is above
- 14 five percent (5%) in each of the following locations:
