1 AN ACT relating to Medicaid coverage for postpartum behavioral healthcare.

## Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

- 3 → Section 1. KRS 205.592 is amended to read as follows:
- 4 Pregnant women, new <u>parents[mothers]</u> up to <u>twenty-four (24)[twelve (12)]</u> months
- 5 postpartum, and children up to age one (1) shall be eligible for participation in the
- 6 Kentucky Medical Assistance Program if:
- 7 (1) They have family income up to but not exceeding one hundred and eighty-five
- 8 percent (185%) of the nonfarm income official poverty guidelines as promulgated
- 9 by the Department of Health and Human Services of the United States as revised
- annually; and

- 11 (2) They are otherwise eligible for the program.
- → Section 2. If the Cabinet for Health and Family Services or the Department for
- 13 Medicaid Services determines that a state plan amendment, waiver, or any other form of
- approval or authorization from a federal agency is necessary prior to the implementation
- of Section 1 of this Act, the cabinet or department shall, within 90 days after the effective
- date of this Act, request the state plan amendment, waiver, approval, or authorization and
- shall only delay full implementation of those provisions for which a state plan
- amendment, waiver, approval, or authorization was deemed necessary until the state plan
- 19 amendment, waiver, approval, or authorization is granted. The cabinet shall, in
- 20 accordance with KRS 205.525, provide a copy of any state plan amendment, waiver, or
- 21 other approval or authorization submitted pursuant to this section to the Interim Joint
- 22 Committee on Health, Welfare, and Family Services and the Interim Joint Committee on
- Appropriations and Revenue and shall provide an update on the status or any application
- submitted pursuant to this section upon request.
- 25 → Section 3. In the event the Legislative Research Commission dissolves the
- 26 Interim Joint Committee on Health, Welfare, and Family Services and establishes another
- 27 interim joint committee with jurisdiction over health services, the report required in
