AN ACT relating to assisted-living communities.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS 194A.700 TO 194A.729 IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

By September 1 of each year, and in accordance with the latest recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, each assisted-living community licensed pursuant to this chapter shall provide residents with educational information on influenza disease. The educational information shall include but not be limited to the following:

- (1) The risks associated with influenza disease;
- (2) The availability, effectiveness, and known contraindications of the influenza immunization;
- (3) The causes and symptoms of influenza; and
- (4) The means by which influenza is spread.

Nothing in this section shall require any assisted-living community to provide or pay for any vaccination against influenza.
