3		→ Section 1. KRS 45A.110 is amended to read as follows:
4	(1)	A written determination of responsibility of a bidder or offeror shall be made and it
5		shall be made in accordance with administrative regulations promulgated by the
6		secretary of the Finance and Administration Cabinet. A reasonable inquiry to
7		determine the responsibility of a bidder or offeror may be conducted. The failure of
8		a bidder or offeror to promptly supply information in connection with such an
9		inquiry may be grounds for a determination of nonresponsibility with respect to
10		such a bidder or offeror.
11	(2)	A written determination of responsibility of a bidder or offeror shall not be made
12		until the bidder or offeror provides the secretary of the Finance and Administration
13		Cabinet with his <u>or her</u> sworn statement made under penalty of perjury that:
14		(a) He or she has: [ not]
15		1. Never knowingly violated any provision of the campaign finance laws of
16		the Commonwealth <u>; and</u>
17		2. Not had two (2) or more civil penalties under KRS 337.990, 338.991,
18		339.990, or 341.990 imposed on him or her within the past five (5)
19		<u>years;</u> and
20		(b) [that] The award of a contract to a bidder or offeror will not violate any
21		provision of the campaign finance laws of the Commonwealth.
22		"Knowingly" means, with respect to conduct or to a circumstance described by a
23		statute defining an offense, that a person is aware or should have been aware that
24		his <u>or her</u> conduct is of that nature or that the circumstance exists.
25	(3)	Except as otherwise provided by law, information furnished by a bidder or offeror
26		pursuant to this section may not be disclosed outside of the Division of State
