

1 AN ACT relating to jockeys fees.

2 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:*

3 ➔SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 230 IS CREATED TO
4 READ AS FOLLOWS:

5 (1) As used in this section, unless the context otherwise requires:

6 (a) "Jockey" means a rider currently licensed to ride in races as a jockey, an
7 apprentice jockey, or a provisional jockey permitted by the stewards to ride
8 in three (3) races prior to applying for a license; and

9 (b) "Jockey losing mount fee" or "losing mount fee" means the amount paid
10 to jockeys who finish out the top four (4) spots in a thoroughbred race.

11 (2) For thoroughbred racing, losing mount fees are as follows:

<u>Purse</u>	<u>Losing Mount</u>
13 <u>Up to \$9,999</u>	<u>\$70</u>
14 <u>\$10,000-\$14,999</u>	<u>\$75</u>
15 <u>\$15,000-\$17,999</u>	<u>\$75</u>
16 <u>\$18,000-\$24,999</u>	<u>\$80</u>
17 <u>\$25,000-\$49,999</u>	<u>\$85</u>
18 <u>\$50,000-\$99,999</u>	<u>\$90</u>
19 <u>\$100,000 and up</u>	<u>\$115</u>

20 (3) Two (2) years from the effective date of this Act and every two (2) years after, the
21 losing mount fee shall be adjusted to not less than the average increase of
22 contiguous states.
