Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

- 3 → Section 1. KRS 311.599 is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (1) When a hearing or inquiry panel has probable cause to believe a physician is
- 5 suffering from a physical or mental condition that might impede his *or her* ability to
- 6 practice competently, the panel may order the physician to undergo a physical or
- 7 mental examination by persons designated by the panel.
- 8 (2) Failure of a physician to submit to such an examination when directed, unless the
- 9 failure was due to circumstances beyond his *or her* control, shall constitute an
- admission that the concerned physician has developed such a physical or mental
- disability, or other conditions, that continued practice is dangerous to patients or to
- the public; said failure shall constitute a default and a final order may be entered
- without the taking of testimony or presentation of evidence.
- 14 (3) A physician whose license has been suspended, limited, restricted or revoked under
- this section and KRS 311.595(8), shall at reasonable intervals be afforded an
- opportunity to demonstrate that he can resume the competent practice of medicine
- with reasonable skill and safety to patients.
