

1 AN ACT relating to Daylight Saving Time.

2 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:*

3 ➔SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 2 IS CREATED TO
4 READ AS FOLLOWS:

5 (1) As used in this section:

6 (a) "Central Daylight Time" means the time five (5) hours behind Coordinated
7 Universal Time and is known as Daylight Saving Time in the Central Time
8 Zone;

9 (b) "Coordinated Universal Time" means the time scale maintained through
10 the General Conference of Weights and Measures and interpreted or
11 modified for the United States by the Secretary of Commerce in
12 coordination with the Secretary of the Navy;

13 (c) "Daylight Saving Time" means time as adjusted to achieve longer evening
14 daylight by setting the clocks one (1) hour ahead of standard time; and

15 (d) "Eastern Daylight Time" means the time four (4) hours behind
16 Coordinated Universal Time and is known as Daylight Saving Time in the
17 Eastern Time Zone.

18 (2) If the United States Congress amends the Standard Time Act of 1918 or the
19 Uniform Time Act of 1966, 15 U.S.C. sec. 260 et seq., to allow states to observe
20 Daylight Saving Time year-round, the official year-round time of the
21 Commonwealth of Kentucky and its political subdivisions shall be:

22 (a) Central Daylight Time in the part of this state that is in the Central Time
23 Zone; and

24 (b) Eastern Daylight Time in the part of this state that is in the Eastern Time
25 Zone.
