- 1 A JOINT RESOLUTION relating to school safety.
- WHEREAS, the first right recognized under Section 1 of the Kentucky Constitution
- 3 is the right of enjoying and defending lives and liberties; and
- 4 WHEREAS, an essential duty of the Commonwealth is protecting the lives of our
- 5 children; and
- 6 WHEREAS, providing security of our public schools will help ensure the safety of
- 7 our children; and
- 8 WHEREAS, more information is needed in order to better guide the General
- 9 Assembly's efforts to provide security to our public schools;
- 10 NOW, THEREFORE,
- 11 Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
- → Section 1. The General Assembly does hereby direct the Commissioner of
- 13 Education, with the assistance of the Kentucky Center for School Safety, to conduct a
- statewide survey to gather data on steps each school has taken to ensure students' safety,
- including but not limited to utilization of surveillance systems, secure entry systems,
- trainings, and school resource officers.
- → Section 2. The Commissioner of Education shall submit a report to the Interim
- 18 Joint Committee on Education by no later than November 1, 2018, that details the results
- 19 of the survey.
- 20 → Section 3. Copies of this Joint Resolution shall be sent by the Clerk of the
