A RESOLUTION recognizing March as Music in Our Schools Month.

3	no boundaries of time and place; and
4	WHEREAS, the study of music is essential to a complete, well-rounded, and
5	comprehensive education and fosters a richer understanding of human expression and
6	culture; and
7	WHEREAS, music education engages children in developing proficiencies in
8	creativity, self-expression, problem solving, and evaluative and mathematical skills; and
9	WHEREAS, music programs enable students to acquire practical experiences in
10	shared responsibility, teamwork, leadership, and public production and performance; and
11	WHEREAS, the National Association for Music Education, an organization of
12	more than 75,000 active and retired music teachers and 60,000 honor students, has
13	arranged a variety of musical activities in the name of Music in Our Schools Month to be
14	enjoyed by children and adults across the nation; and
15	WHEREAS, since its modest beginnings in 1973, Music in Our Schools Month is
16	now celebrated by hundreds of thousands of children, friends, and families who join
17	together to rejoice in the timeless power of music in our schools and in our communities;

19	Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the
20	Commonwealth of Kentucky:
21	→ Section 1. The members of the House of Representatives hereby recognize
22	March as Music in Our Schools Month in the Commonwealth of Kentucky, endorse the
23	observance as an opportunity to support the purposes and practices of music education
24	and encourage all citizens to participate.
