8	Anniversary Commission was created by the General Assembly during the 2016 Regular

12	Kentucky 225th Anniversary Commission is administered by the Tourism, Arts and

15	with the Kentucky 225th Anniversary Commission are duly recognized on this day; and
16	WHEREAS, in so doing, the members of this august body acknowledge all those
17	who have made this Commonwealth a special place to live and work, and commend those
18	who continue to envision a better, brighter future for their Old Kentucky Home;
19	NOW, THEREFORE,
20	Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the
21	Commonwealth of Kentucky:
22	\Rightarrow Section 1. The members of the House of Representatives hereby recognize the
23	Kentucky 225th Anniversary Commission, congratulate the Commission on its successful
24	work so far, and acknowledge the many partners and volunteers who have helped the
25	Commission realize its mission of celebrating Kentucky's 225th year of statehood.
