

1 A RESOLUTION recognizing the Kentucky Community and Technical College  
2 System's 20th anniversary.

3 WHEREAS, the Kentucky General Assembly created the Kentucky Community and  
4 Technical College System (KCTCS) through the Kentucky Postsecondary Education  
5 Improvement Act of 1997; and

6 WHEREAS, KCTCS is the Commonwealth's ninth unique public postsecondary  
7 institution, serving more than 100,000 students annually; and

8 WHEREAS, KCTCS is the largest provider of postsecondary, online, and  
9 workforce education in Kentucky; and

10 WHEREAS, KCTCS has increased the number of college credentials awarded in  
11 Kentucky by 250%; and

12 WHEREAS, in 2017, KCTCS celebrated the largest number of graduates and  
13 credentials awarded in the system's history; and

14 WHEREAS, KCTCS has served three million participants in its Workforce  
15 Solutions program; and

16 WHEREAS, KCTCS has served 875,000 Kentuckians in the last 20 years; and

17 WHEREAS, KCTCS, its students, and its alumni contribute \$2.3 billion to  
18 Kentucky's economy; and

19 WHEREAS, KCTCS has been called the crown jewel of higher education reform in  
20 Kentucky by the National Center for Higher Education Management Systems;
