1	A RESOLUTION	urging Congress	to lift restrictions	on the coal industry.

- WHEREAS, coal has provided the Commonwealth of Kentucky and generations of
- 3 Kentuckians with low-cost electric power, excellent job opportunities, economic vitality,
- 4 and a reliable stream of tax revenue; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the regulatory burden on the coal industry has grown greater with each
- 6 passing year, chasing ever-stricter emission limitations, and rendering a vibrant enterprise
- 7 less viable with each added mandate; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the decline of the coal industry has had profound impacts on the coal
- 9 fields of eastern and western Kentucky, on state budgets, and on the ability of the
- 10 Commonwealth to compete for new economic opportunities; and
- WHEREAS, the future appears increasingly bleak with no new coal-fired
- generation facilities, a withering of the mining industry, and a relentless upward spiral of
- 13 electricity prices.
- 14 NOW, THEREFORE,
- 15 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the
- 16 Commonwealth of Kentucky:
- → Section 1. This honorable body urges the Congress of the United States to take
- all necessary steps within its power to reduce the regulatory burden placed upon the coal
- 19 industry that has resulted in so much poverty, unemployment, and misery in this
- 20 Commonwealth and elsewhere in the Appalachian coal fields.
- 21 → Section 2. The Clerk of the House of Representatives is directed to provide
- 22 copies of this resolution to Representative Angie Hatton and to each member of the
- 23 Kentucky Congressional delegation.
