

1 AN ACT relating to agricultural land.

2 ***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

3 ➔Section 1. KRS 211.015 is amended to read as follows:

4 (1) As used in KRS 211.005 to 211.380, unless the context requires otherwise:

5 (a) "Cabinet" means the Cabinet for Health and Family Services;

6 (b) **1.** "Farmstead" means a farm dwelling, together with other farm buildings  
7 and structures incident to the operation and maintenance of the farm,  
8 situated on ten (10) contiguous acres or more of land outside the  
9 corporate limits of a municipality:

10 **a.**~~[1.]~~Used for the production of livestock, livestock products, poultry,  
11 poultry products, dairy, dairy products, or horticulture products or  
12 for the growing of crops such as, but not limited to, tobacco, corn,  
13 soybeans, and wheat. For purposes of this  
14 **subparagraph**~~[paragraph]~~, "livestock" means cattle, sheep, swine,  
15 goats, horses, alpacas, llamas, buffaloes, or any other animals of  
16 the bovine, ovine, porcine, caprine, equine, or camelid species; or

17 **b.**~~[2.]~~Where devoted to and meeting the requirements and qualifications  
18 for payments pursuant to agriculture programs under an agreement  
19 with the state or federal government.

20 **2. "Farmstead" also means farm buildings and structures incident to the**  
21 **operation and maintenance of the farm, excluding any residential**  
22 **dwelling or other structure or facility unrelated to farming, situated on**  
23 **five (5) contiguous acres or more of land outside the corporate limits**  
24 **of a municipality:**

25 **a. Used for the production of livestock, livestock products, poultry,**  
26 **poultry products, dairy, dairy products, or horticulture products**  
27 **or for the growing of crops such as, but not limited to, tobacco,**

1                                   corn, soybeans, and wheat. For purposes of this subparagraph,  
 2                                   "livestock" means cattle, sheep, swine, goats, horses, alpacas,  
 3                                   llamas, buffaloes, or any other animals of the bovine, ovine,  
 4                                   porcine, caprine, equine, or camelid species; or

5                                   b. Where devoted to and meeting the requirements and  
 6                                   qualifications for payments pursuant to agriculture programs  
 7                                   under an agreement with the state or federal government;

8           (c) "Secretary" means the secretary of the Cabinet for Health and Family  
 9           Services; and

10          (d) "Private water supply" means a residential water supply located on private  
 11          property under the control of a person holding a possessory interest in the  
 12          property, the use of which is limited to family members.

13   (2) As used in KRS 200.560 and 200.550, unless the context otherwise requires:

14          (a) "Department" means Department for Public Health;

15          (b) "Commissioner" means the commissioner of the Department for Public  
 16          Health;

17          (c) "Committee" means the Hemophilia Advisory Committee; and

18          (d) "Hemophilia" means a bleeding disorder resulting from a genetically  
 19          determined deficiency factor in the blood, or hereditarily resulting in an  
 20          abnormal or deficient plasma procoagulant.

21          ➔Section 2. KRS 318.010 is amended to read as follows:

22          As used in this chapter, unless the context requires otherwise:

23          (1) "Department" means Department of Housing, Buildings and Construction;

24          (2) "Journeyman plumber" means a person who engages or offers to engage, either as  
 25          an occupation or otherwise, in the construction, installation, alteration,  
 26          maintenance, repair, remodeling or removal, and replacement of plumbing under the  
 27          supervision, direction, and responsibility of a master plumber;

- 1 (3) "Master plumber" means a person who assumes responsible charge, supervision, or  
2 direction of journeyman plumbers, plumbers' apprentices, and other persons in the  
3 construction, installation, or alteration of plumbing or who engages in, offers to  
4 engage in, or advertises or otherwise represents that he is permitted or qualified to  
5 engage in the design, planning, superintending, contracting for, or responsible  
6 charge of plumbing;
- 7 (4) "Plumbing" means the art of installing in buildings the pipes for distributing the  
8 water supply, the fixtures for using water and drainage pipes for removing waste  
9 water and sewage, together with fittings, appurtenances, and appliances of various  
10 kinds, all within or adjacent to the building. It shall not include the installation of  
11 on-site sewage disposal systems, except for the piping, fixtures, or other  
12 appurtenances needed within the building. It shall include:
- 13 (a) The water service pipe which forms the connection between the property line  
14 and the building, other than piping serving firefighting equipment;
- 15 (b) Private water supply systems;
- 16 (c) House sewers which convey the waste water and sewage from the building to  
17 the property line or other points of disposal, but not including sewers located  
18 between manholes and sewers extending five (5) feet from a main or manhole  
19 on private property;
- 20 (d) Storm sewers and rain water piping located within a building to a point two  
21 (2) feet outside of the building; and
- 22 (e) Medical gas piping;
- 23 (5) "Public building" means any building intended for public use or built with public  
24 funds and includes but is not limited to the following: schools, industrial  
25 establishments, housing projects, restaurants, food-handling establishments, private  
26 clubs, theaters including drive-ins, trailer coach parks, camping areas, hospitals,  
27 nursing homes, hotels, motels, tourist courts, rooming houses, boarding houses, and

- 1 other establishments furnishing public sleeping accommodations;
- 2 (6) "Maintenance man" means a person employed to maintain and keep plumbing in  
3 good repair;
- 4 (7) "Apprentice" means a person in the process of learning the plumbing trade who  
5 assists and is under the personal supervision of a licensed master or licensed  
6 journeyman plumber;
- 7 (8) (a) "Farmstead" means a farm dwelling together with other farm buildings and  
8 structures incident to the operation and maintenance of the farm situated on  
9 ten (10) acres or more of land which is located outside the corporate limits of  
10 a municipality.
- 11 (b) "Farmstead" also means farm buildings and structures incident to the  
12 operation and maintenance of the farm, excluding any residential dwelling  
13 or other structure or facility unrelated to farming, situated on five (5) acres  
14 or more of land which is located outside the corporate limits of a  
15 municipality;
- 16 (9) "Person" means any individual, public or private corporation, political subdivision,  
17 government agency, municipality, copartnership, association, firm, trust, estate, or  
18 other entity whatsoever;
- 19 (10) "Commissioner" means the commissioner of the Department of Housing, Buildings  
20 and Construction; and
- 21 (11) "Code" means the Kentucky State Plumbing Code.
