

1 AN ACT relating to biosolids.

2 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:*

3 ➔SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF SUBCHAPTER 50 OF KRS CHAPTER  
4 224 IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

5 *(1) As used in this section, "biosolids" means nutrient-rich, organic, residual*  
6 *material that results from the treatment of domestic sewage or sewage sludge in a*  
7 *treatment facility and can be recycled and applied as a fertilizer to improve and*  
8 *maintain productive soils.*

9 *(2) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, when biosolids are*  
10 *generated from wastewater treatment at a publicly owned treatment works, the*  
11 *biosolids shall be:*

12 *(a) Designated a special waste; and*

13 *(b) Regulated in conformance with the most recent version of 40 C.F.R. pt. 503.*

14 *(3) Within sixty (60) days of the effective date of this Act, the cabinet shall*  
15 *promulgate administrative regulations pursuant to KRS Chapter 13A that are in*  
16 *conformance with 40 C.F.R. pt. 503, regarding siting criteria and permitting*  
17 *conditions necessary to regulate the disposal of biosolids.*
