- 3 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
- Section 1. There is hereby appropriated General Fund moneys in the amount of

- 5 \$3,250,000 in fiscal year 2022-2023 and \$3,250,000 in fiscal year 2023-2024 to the
- 6 Department of Revenue for the development of an online tangible personal property tax
- 7 filing system. Expenditures shall conform to KRS 45.750 to 45.818 and applicable
- 8 provisions of the State/Executive Branch Budget. If possible, the online system shall:
- 9 (1) Allow business owners to file tangible personal property tax returns 10 electronically with the property valuation administration;
- 11 (2) Assign the tangible personal property tax returns to the proper taxing district;
- 12 (3) Handle the omitted tangible personal property tax billing process at the state
- 13 level; and
- 14 (4) Manage the distribution of local funds collected from omitted tangible
- personal property tax bills.
- → Section 2. Whereas the development of an online system would modernize the
- 17 filing of tangible personal property tax returns, an emergency is declared to exist, and this
- Act takes effect upon its passage and approval by the Governor or upon its otherwise
- 19 becoming a law.
