

AN ACT relating to public protection.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

➔Section 1. KRS 433.750 is amended to read as follows:

Any person who picks, pulls, digs, tears up, cuts, breaks, burns, or otherwise damages any tree, shrub, flower, vine, bush, or turf on the right of way of any state highway or county road, or upon any land set aside, dedicated or maintained by this state as a public park or as a refuge or sanctuary for wild animals, birds, *insects*, or fish, without having first obtained permission in writing of the engineer having charge of the maintenance of the highway, or the superintendent or custodian of the park, refuge, or sanctuary shall be fined not less than \$25 nor more than \$300.
