AN ACT relating to audiovisual recording of animal inspections.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 525 IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

Unless otherwise prohibited by federal law, the owner or a designee of the owner of any animal that is subject to an inspection in this state for the purpose of determining compliance with any statutory or regulatory requirement shall be permitted to:

- (1) Personally record such inspection by audiovisual means or other electronic means; or
- (2) Designate an agent to record such inspection by audiovisual means or other electronic means.
