2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:		
3		⇒s	ection 1. KRS 61.395 is amended to read as follows:
4	(1)	As used in this section:	
5		(a)	"Disaster" means disasters designated at level III and above in the American
6			National Red Cross Regulations and Procedures; and
7		(b)	"State agency" means all departments, offices, commissions, boards,
8			institutions, and political and corporate bodies of the state, including the
9			offices of the clerk of the Supreme Court, clerks of the appellate courts, the
10			several courts of the state, and the legislature, its committees, or commissions.
11	(2)	<u>(a)</u>	An employee of a state agency who is a certified disaster services volunteer of
12			the American Red Cross may be granted leave from work with pay for not to
13			exceed thirty (30) work days in any twelve (12) month period to participate in
14			specialized disaster relief services for the American Red Cross for the services
15			of that employee and upon the approval of that employee's agency, without
16			loss of seniority, pay, vacation time, sick time, compensatory time, or earned
17			overtime accumulation.
18		<u>(b)</u>	The agency shall compensate an employee granted leave under this section at
19			the regular rate of pay for those regular work hours during which the
20			employee is absent from work.
21	(3)	This	s section may be cited as the Disaster Services Volunteer Leave Act.
