6	<u>(2)</u>	(a)	A victim service provider shall have legal standing to file a civil action
17			against any defendant convicted of any human trafficking offense under
8			KRS Chapter 529 if the victim of the offense has not proceeded as provided
9			in KRS 431.082 or any other applicable statute or common law right of
20			action.
21		<u>(b)</u>	Before initiating any civil action under this section, the provider shall give
22			notice to any human trafficking victim directly impacted by the human
23			trafficking actions of the defendant.
24		<u>(c)</u>	Each victim shall be given a reasonable opportunity to join the civil action
25			as a plaintiff.
26	<u>(3)</u>	If a	victim elects to not join the civil action as a plaintiff, the victim service

1	<i>(4)</i>	Any victim service provider proceeding under this section shall give written notice
2		to the Attorney General of the proceeding, and the Attorney General may join as
3		a plaintiff to the action.
4	<u>(5)</u>	The victim service provider shall maintain comprehensive documentation of the
5		provided services to victims of human trafficking and of the process of notifying
6		and inviting the victims to join the legal action. The documentation shall be
7		available for review by the Attorney General upon request, and by the court as
8		determined by the court.
9	<u>(6)</u>	A prevailing plaintiff shall be entitled to all damages provided under KRS
10		<u>431.082.</u>
11	<u>(7)</u>	Money damages received under this section shall be distributed to any
12		participating victim and victim service provider in amounts determined by the
13		jury or the court if the matter was tried without a jury. Any remaining damages
14		shall be remitted to the human trafficking victims fund established in KRS
