2 Michael Bailey.

4 born in Louisville on December 4, 1955, to the late Ida Morris Bailey and Robert Fulton
5 Bailey; and

6 WHEREAS, a proud 1974 graduate of duPont Manual High School, Walter
7 Michael Bailey worked for 16 years with the Transit Authority of River City as a bus
8 operator; and

9 WHEREAS, Walter Michael Bailey was an ardent supporter of University of
10 Louisville men's basketball, and a fan of Julius "Dr. J" Erving. A talented dog trainer, he
11 was a jazz and blues enthusiast who trained himself to play guitar; and

12 WHEREAS, Walter Michael Bailey, proud Louisvillian and beloved father, brother,
13 and uncle, departed this earthly life on February 21, 2021, leaving all those whose lives
14 he touched in solemn mourning; and

15 WHEREAS, Walter Michael Bailey was preceded in death by his parents and his
16 ex-wife and high school sweetheart, Dorothea Larue Harris-Bailey. He is survived by his
17 beloved son, Phillip M. Bailey; brother, Robert Bailey Jr.; sister, Sheila Bailey; aunt,
