

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Zane
2 Eldon Cunningham.

3 WHEREAS, Zane Cunningham was born in Kirksey, Kentucky, on April 20, 1933,
4 the son of the late Paul and Estelle Cunningham; and

5 WHEREAS, Zane Cunningham was a proud veteran of the United States Army who
6 served in the Korean War and in the Panama Canal Zone; and

7 WHEREAS, Zane Cunningham went on to graduate from Murray State University,
8 earning his bachelor's in business before being hired by WoodmenLife as a sales
9 representative; and

10 WHEREAS, in the 1970s, Zane Cunningham worked in real estate with Gibson
11 Realty, RE/Max, and Cunningham Real Estate; and

12 WHEREAS, Zane Cunningham served as president of the Kiwanis Club and the
13 Bowling Green Board of Realtors, and was a member of the Red Cross Board of
14 Directors and the First Baptist Church of Bowling Green; and

15 WHEREAS, Zane Eldon Cunningham, beloved husband, father, and grandfather,
16 departed this earthly life and entered into the kingdom of Heaven, leaving his family,
17 friends, and all those whose lives he touched in solemn mourning; and

18 WHEREAS, Zane Cunningham is survived by his wife of 53 years, Emily Zane
19 Miller Cunningham; children, Philip Zane Cunningham and his wife, Danielle, and Joy
20 Cunningham; grandchildren, Nathaniel Parker, Daniel Zane, and Ellory Zane; and a host
21 of other family members, friends, and loved ones who will dearly miss his presence in
22 their lives;
