10 Learning Center, supporting education in their Northern Kentucky community by
11 providing pathways to success for those in need; and

12 WHEREAS, Sue Butler was a founding board member of Northern Kentucky
13 Harvest and served on the boards of The Carnegie Visual and Performing Arts Center of
14 Covington, Kentucky, and the Cincinnati Zoo and Botanical Gardens; and

15 WHEREAS, Sue Butler also volunteered for the St. Elizabeth Medical Center
16 Foundation, where she helped to raise funds for a much-needed inpatient Hospice Center
17 in Northern Kentucky; and

18 WHEREAS, Sue Butler was a faithful member of both Mother of God Church in
19 Covington, Kentucky, and Holy Spirit Parish in Newport, Kentucky; and

20 WHEREAS, Sue Butler took great joy and care in creating personalized needlepoint
21 art for those she loved, and most enjoyed making fun memories with her family and
22 friends; and

23 WHEREAS, Sue Butler cherished her four grandchildren, and she will be dearly
24 missed by all her extended family and a host of close friends;
