

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Charles
2 "Louis" Travis.

3 WHEREAS, Louis Travis was a son of this Commonwealth, having been born on
4 March 8, 1928, to the late Charles and Martha Tandy Travis; and

5 WHEREAS, Louis Travis was a proud veteran of the United States Navy who
6 served in the Korean War; and

7 WHEREAS, the owner of Travis Photo Studio who retired as a veteran's
8 employment counselor at the Veteran's Hospital in Lexington, Louis Travis also served
9 for two terms on the Franklin County School Board and as a Kentucky State Trooper; and

10 WHEREAS, Louis Travis was a member of the Nicholasville United Methodist
11 Church and Bethel Christian Church. A Mason and a member of the Oleika Shrine
12 temple, he was a longtime pillar of his community who had served with many civic
13 organizations, including the Kentucky River Task Force; and

14 WHEREAS, Louis Travis departed this earthly life and entered into the kingdom of
15 Heaven on January 29, 2018, leaving his family, friends, and all those whose lives he
16 touched in solemn mourning; and

17 WHEREAS, Louis Travis was preceded in death by his parents and several siblings.
18 He is survived by his wife, JoAnn Travis; children, Milt Travis and his wife, Angie,
19 Martha Sandlin and her husband, Rick, and Randy Swaenepoel and his wife, Norma;
20 brother, Jack Travis; eight grandchildren; 12 great-grandchildren; and a host of other
21 family members, friends, and loved ones who will dearly miss his presence in their lives;
