2	WHEREAS, for more than 200 years, the Sisters of Loretto has served as a
3	community that exists to praise God and minister to people of faith through service, love,
4	and an enduring devotion to the human spirit; and
5	WHEREAS, founded in Kentucky in 1812, the Sisters of Loretta was one of the
6	first Roman Catholic communities of women established in the United States; and
7	WHEREAS, the Loretto Motherhouse, the traditional home place for the Sisters of
8	Loretto, is located in Nerinx, Kentucky, in Marion County; and
9	WHEREAS, in December 2017, two members of the Sisters of Loretto community,
10	Sister Kay Carlew and Sister Maria Visse, traveled to Ghana, West Africa, to offer
11	education and health services and to assist the local people with myriad issues of need;
12	and
13	WHEREAS, upon their return, the sisters noted the importance of telling others
14	about all they witnessed in Africa, and of informing people about how the citizens of
15	Ghana are no different than us in their pursuit of dignity and happiness; and
16	WHEREAS, Sister Visse particularly noted how the Sisters of Loretto "try to share
17	our respect for people, other countries, and cultures." The sisters also commended the
18	education in Ghana and how the local citizens "value education and know that education
19	is the way to improve themselves." The Sisters of Loretto, who first traveled to Africa
20	two decades ago, have always attempted to improve the educational opportunities for the
21	regions they assist; and
22	WHEREAS, it is rightful that this honorable body commend Sisters of Loretto for
23	all they have accomplished in dutiful service of Christ's good will; and
24	WHEREAS, in so doing, the body acknowledges the trip to Ghana taken by Sisters
25	Kay Carlew and Maria Visse; notes the unbreakable spirit shared by the Sisters of
26	Loretto; and thanks them for their message of compassion, spiritual values, and the
27	ongoing pursuit of justice and peace;
