- WHEREAS, the Amputee Coalition of America provides education, outreach,
- advocacy, and a National Limb Loss Information Center for the benefit of persons with
- limb loss/difference, their families, and healthcare providers; and
- WHEREAS, April is an appropriate month to designate as Limb Loss Awareness
- Month as spring is a time of renewal and inspiration;
