

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Doyle

3 WHEREAS, Doyle Terry Crenshaw, a son of Hardyville, Kentucky, was born on
4 January 18, 1924, to the late Richard Wesley Crenshaw and Amanda Susan Crenshaw;

6 WHEREAS, Doyle Terry Crenshaw was a World War II veteran who, upon return
7 to his community, had an accomplished professional career in banking. He was a retired
8 Bank President, having worked with the Bank of Fordsville, Hartford Bank and Trust,
9 Marion National Bank, Gravel Switch Peoples Bank, Edmonton State Bank, and First and
10 Peoples Bank of Springfield; and

11 WHEREAS, Doyle Terry Crenshaw was an active, committed, and devout member
12 of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints; and

13 WHEREAS, on February 22, 2018, Doyle Terry Crenshaw was called home to be
14 with his Lord, leaving his family, friends, and all of those that he impacted during his
15 time on earth in mourning; and

16 WHEREAS, Doyle Terry Crenshaw is survived by his beloved wife, Lena Belle
17 Crenshaw; his treasured children, Larry Crenshaw and his wife, Cheryl, and Gary
18 Crenshaw and his wife, Angela; his stepchildren, Barbara Bottom, Franklin Lee Woods
19 Jr., and Tony J. Bailey and his wife, Melissa; his ex-spouse, Lola Crenshaw; and eight
20 grandchildren, 18 great-grandchildren, and many other family and friends;
