

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Vincent
2 "Van" Warren.

3 WHEREAS, Van Warren was a son of this Commonwealth, having been born on
4 April 10, 1933, to the late Helen Warren; and

5 WHEREAS, Van Warren was a 1951 graduate of Mayo-Underwood High School,
6 where he lettered in basketball. He would go on to play basketball at Kentucky State
7 University, and would courageously serve his country as a member of the United States
8 Air Force; and

9 WHEREAS, Van Warren was a retired state EEO coordinator in the Personnel
10 Cabinet; and

11 WHEREAS, Van Warren was a member and deacon at First Corinthian Baptist
12 Church; and

13 WHEREAS, for 20 years, Van Warren proudly served the Kentucky General
14 Assembly as a doorkeeper in the Senate, and his service to this honorable body is
15 rightfully commended on this day; and

16 WHEREAS, Van Warren, beloved father, mentor, and steward of this august body,
17 departed this earthly life on March 12, 2018, leaving his family, friends, and all those
18 whose lives he touched in solemn mourning; and

19 WHEREAS, Van Warren is survived by his son, Edward Gerard Warren, and a host
20 of other family members, friends, and loved ones who will dearly miss his presence in
21 their lives;

25 ➔Section 1. The members of the Senate hereby express their most profound
26 sympathy upon the passing of Vincent "Van" Warren, and extend heartfelt condolences to
27 his family, friends, and loved ones in this time of loss.
