3	WHEREAS, Representative Mary Lou Marzian has been a progressive, decades-
4	long veteran of the Kentucky General Assembly and a steadfast voice for the 34th House
5	of Representatives District; and
6	WHEREAS, Representative Mary Lou Marzian grew up in Louisville as one of
7	eight children in a Catholic family. She learned early on how to get attention with her
8	voice and is known to be persistent, driven, and passionate; and
9	WHEREAS, Representative Mary Lou Marzian graduated from the University of
10	Louisville with a Bachelor's degree in nursing and dedicated herself to the nursing
11	profession for 38 years, working at Jewish Hospital and University Hospital in the kidney
12	disease transplant program, helping thousands of patients in their most difficult time; and
13	WHEREAS, Representative Mary Lou Marzian is married to Billy and they have a
14	daughter, Nicky; and
15	WHEREAS, Representative Mary Lou Marzian began her impressive and
16	remarkable legislative career in 1994, representing District 34 where she has been a fierce
17	and ferocious advocate for the voiceless, the underserved, and the helpless; and
18	WHEREAS, Representative Mary Lou Marzian has advocated for reproductive and
19	women's healthcare rights and as only one of five female members of the Democratic
20	House Caucus, beat a path to the Speaker's office on many occasions to sway his mindset;

22	WHEREAS, Representative Mary Lou Marzian led the fight for fairness, including
23	for LGBTQ, racial, and gender equity. She sponsored HB 171, promoting statewide anti-
24	discrimination protections in employment, housing, and public accommodation. She
25	championed labor and the working poor, and stood up for worker's rights and fair wages
26	in every legislative session. She sponsored HCR 17, urging Congress to propose an
27	amendment to the Constitution of the United States to establish reasonable limits on

1 contributions and expenditures in political campaigns and to prohibit noncitizen 2 contributions and expenditures; and 3 WHEREAS, Representative Mary Lou Marzian championed the environmental 4 cause before it was popular. She and her husband frequently take walks and pick up trash 5 and recycling up and down Bardstown Road and in the Highlands neighborhoods in 6 Louisville; and 7 WHEREAS, Representative Mary Lou Marzian established and chairs the General 8 Assembly's Green Schools Caucus, a coalition of bipartisan members from the House and 9 Senate to promote a healthy environment conducive to learning while saving energy, 10 resources, and money. She sponsored the Clean Energy Opportunity Act to include 11 efficiency and renewable energy portfolio standards; and 12 WHEREAS, Representative Mary Lou Marzian never forgot her nursing profession, 13 legislating on behalf of nurses and nurse practitioners to promote policies and laws to 14 help them provide better healthcare to millions of Kentuckians over the decades; and 15 WHEREAS, throughout her career, Representative Mary Lou Marzian participated 16 in numerous organizations including as president of the National Organization for 17 Women, president of the Women's Metropolitan Louisville Political Caucus, and director 18 for the National Organization of Women in Government; and 19 WHEREAS, in her 27 years of service to the House of Representatives, 20 Representative Mary Lou Marzian has served on the Health and Family Services 21 Committee, Judiciary Committee, Labor and Industry Committee, State Government 22 Committee, Local Government Committee, Education Committee, Natural Resources and 23 Energy Committee, and served as vice chair of the Elections, Constitutional 24 Amendments, and Intergovernmental Affairs Committee; and 25 WHEREAS, Representative Mary Lou Marzian has given her time and talent to 26 organizations, causes, and critical social movements, often stepping in to lead the way 27 when there was a gap in leadership.
