

1           A RESOLUTION honoring George McGee upon his retirement from Georgetown  
2 College.

3           WHEREAS, George McGee has proudly served as a professor at Georgetown  
4 College since 1984; and

5           WHEREAS, George McGee holds a bachelor's degree in fine arts in theatre from  
6 Illinois Wesleyan University and a master's degree in fine arts from Florida Atlantic  
7 University; and

8           WHEREAS, a talented playwright, George McGee has had four of his plays  
9 produced at the Kentucky State Fair as part of the Kentucky New Play Series. He has also  
10 been commissioned by the Kentucky Playwrights Workshop, Inc., to write a 30-minute  
11 play that was first presented in Louisville in 2015, and which has been produced on  
12 several occasions since then; and

13           WHEREAS, George McGee is also a veteran actor, known for his turn as Henry  
14 Clay for the Kentucky Humanities Council's Chautauqua Program. He served as artistic  
15 director of the Palm Beach Children's Theater, and his play *A Fence for Martin Maher*  
16 toured Kentucky and Ireland as part of the Smithsonian *Between Fences* Exhibit; and

17           WHEREAS, it is appropriate that this honorable body commends those artists and  
18 educators in this Commonwealth whose work impacts the greater good, and in doing so  
19 the members honor George McKee on this day upon his well-deserved retirement from  
20 Georgetown College, thank him for his more than three decades of service to one of  
21 Kentucky's finest institutions of higher learning, and grant him best wishes in all his  
22 future endeavors;

23           NOW, THEREFORE,

24 ***Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of***  
25 ***Kentucky:***

26           ➔Section 1. The members of the Senate hereby honor George McGee upon his  
27 retirement from Georgetown College, and thank him for all he has accomplished on

1    behalf of the dramatic arts in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

2           ➔Section 2.   When the Senate adjourns this day, it does so in honor of George  
3    McGee.
