15	WHEREAS, Henry graduated from George Washington University in 2021 and
16	became Deputy Press Secretary for the Human Rights Campaign in Washington, DC,
17	which is one of the nation's largest LGBTQ+ advocacy organizations; and

19	safe and accepting place for all, his voice for change will be missed and not forgotten;
