4 Delaney; and

5           WHEREAS, Brady Delaney was an esteemed resident of Alexandria, Kentucky,  
6 and a 2022 graduate of Campbell County High School. He was a five-year player and  
7 team captain of the CCHS soccer team. He had a "team first" mentality and his positive  
8 attitude has forever resonated with opponents and teammates alike; and

9           WHEREAS, Brady Delaney became a licensed realtor at the age of 19 for Keller  
10 Williams Realty, Inc., where he earned the 2023 Debbie Marshall Robke Productivity  
11 Award. He was a dedicated employee of Planet Fitness in Alexandria where he was loved  
12 by the staff and patrons. He was the first to share words of encouragement or give you a
