3 two decades; and

4 WHEREAS, a graduate of the University of Kentucky College of Law, Mark  
5 Gormley has for many years operated a private law practice in his beloved hometown of  
6 Versailles, Kentucky; and

7 WHEREAS, returning home from a short stint in Denver, Colorado, where he tried  
8 his first case before the United States Court of Appeals, Mark Gormley was elected as  
9 Woodford County Attorney in 1973, and was re-elected five times to that esteemed  
10 office; and

11 WHEREAS, also serving as Master Commissioner, Director for Savings and Loan,  
12 and a hearing officer for the Commonwealth's Cabinet for Environmental Protection,  
13 Mark Gormley has always been known for his fairness, his work ethic, and his unflinching  
14 tenacity on behalf of his clients; and

15 WHEREAS, Mark Gormley concluded his tenure as Woodford County Attorney in  
16 1993, but he still handles cases in his private practice at 83 years of age; and

17 WHEREAS, a beloved family man, Mark Gormley is the cherished husband of  
18 Dorothy Gormley and the adoring father of Michael Gormley, Mark Gormley Jr., Tamra  
19 Gormley, and Kathleen Johnson; and

20 WHEREAS, this honorable body rightfully commends Mark Gormley on this day  
21 for his extraordinary service to the citizens of Woodford County, for his decades of work  
22 in the legal profession, and for all he has done on behalf of this Commonwealth;
