2 Pike County Magistrate Kenneth "Jaws" Robinson.

3 WHEREAS, Kenneth Robinson was born May 2, 1940, in Pike County, Kentucky,
4 to Lee and Eunice Robinson; and

5 WHEREAS, Kenneth Robinson married his best friend and loving wife, Billie
6 Joyce Robinson, who would remain his faithful partner for 61 years; and

7 WHEREAS, Kenneth Robinson owned and maintained his own wrecker service
8 and garage for 55 years, a passion he maintained into his later years, and a location that
9 would become a familiar place of joy for his friends, family, and the entire Pike County
10 community; and

11 WHEREAS, Kenneth Robinson proudly served the citizens of Pike County as
12 magistrate for 16 years, where he made a large impact to his community; and

13 WHEREAS, Kenneth Robinson was a dedicated member of both the Masonic
14 Lodge and the Good Ole Boys Car Club; and

15 WHEREAS, Kenneth Robinson departed this earthly life on August 25, 2023, at the
16 age of 83, leaving behind the memory of a man who meant so many different things to so
17 many people as a loving husband, brother, father, uncle, grandfather, and friend; and

18 WHEREAS, Kenneth Robinson is survived by his wife, Billie Joyce Robinson;
19 sister, Katie Clevenger; son, Mark Neil (Kristen) Robinson; and his grandchildren. He
20 was preceded in death by his parents, Lee and Eunice Robinson, and brother, Harold
21 Blake Robinson; and

22 WHEREAS, Kenneth Robinson's legacy lives on through those that knew him, and
23 those who hear of the impact he had on loved ones;
