

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Mr. Ellis
2 W. Shelton.

3 WHEREAS, Ellis W. Shelton was born in Green County, Kentucky on July 1, 1936,
4 to the late Elvis Walter Shelton and Hallie Estes Shelton Beams; and

5 WHEREAS, Ellis W. Shelton was a veteran of the Korean War, having served in
6 the United States Army as a Drill Sergeant. He was a member of the Greensburg Masonic
7 Lodge #54 F&AM, V.F.W. James L. Pruitt Post #5813, a volunteer fireman for the Green
8 County Fire Department, a rescue squad member and ambulance driver, and a past part-
9 time employee for Cowherd and Parrott Funeral Home; and

10 WHEREAS, Ellis W. Shelton married the late Martha Allen Shelton on October 21,
11 1961; and

12 WHEREAS, Ellis W. Shelton departed this earthly life on February 12, 2017,
13 leaving his family, friends, and all those whose lives he touched in solemn mourning; and

14 WHEREAS, in addition to his parents and wife, Ellis Shelton is preceded in passing
15 by a granddaughter, Emma A. Griffiths; and two brothers, Eugene Shelton and Eyonne
16 Beams. He is survived by his daughters, Alicia Taylor and her husband, David, and
17 Allison Griffiths and her husband, Tom; his grandchildren, Alex Taylor and his wife,
18 Kaitlyn, Elliott Taylor, Abbey Griffiths, and Hallie Griffiths; his great-grandson, Deacon
19 Taylor; his brother, Adren Shelton; and many other family and friends; and

20 WHEREAS, Ellis Shelton has had a profound impact on his family, friends, and the
21 Green County community;
