1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "reenact" and before "Code" insert "Section 3 of Act No. 260 of the  
3 2017 Regular Session of the Legislature and"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 3, after "crime;" and before "to prohibit" insert "to provide for the  
6 recordation of a civil money judgment without cost to the person to whom restitution is  
7 owed;"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 1, line 5, after "restitution;" and before "and" insert the following:

10 "to delay the effective date of Act No. 260 of the 2017 Regular Session of the  
11 Legislature which provided relative to the payment of fines, fees, costs,  
12 restitution, and other monetary obligations related to an offender's  
13 conviction;"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 4

15 On page 3, delete lines 25 and 26 in their entirety and insert "F. If restitution is ordered by  
16 the court as a condition of probation, the amount of"

17 AMENDMENT NO. 5

18 On page 3, line 29, after "Procedure." and before "For" insert "A form for the judgment shall  
19 be submitted by the district attorney to the sentencing judge for signature."

20 AMENDMENT NO. 6

21 On page 4, line 1, after "shall" and before "send" insert "record the judgment without charge  
22 to the person to whom restitution is to be paid and shall"

23 AMENDMENT NO. 7

24 On page 4, after line 5, add the following:

25 "Section 2. Section 3 of Act No. 260 of the 2017 Regular Session of  
26 the Legislature is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

27 Section 3. The provisions of this Act shall become effective on  
28 August 1, ~~2018~~ 2019."
